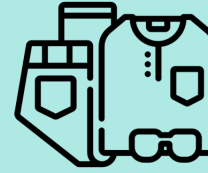

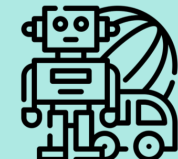

### Tips to Reduce Waste During A Move

- Visit [reuse.dc.gov](https://reuse.dc.gov) to learn how to donate or exchange items with neighbors.
- Check-out the list of organizations that will pick-up from your house!
- Make a plan early, so that you aren't rushed to donate when also packing.
- Go through your home one room at a time and decide what to donate.
- Instead of buying moving boxes, rent crates or use old boxes. Some moving companies provide rentable crates.
- Use old newspapers, old towels, shirts, or socks for packing.
- Pack carefully to avoid damage during transit.
